

# Go Fish

## Instructions:

On heavy paper or cardstock, print out either the two colored fish pages or the blank fish page. If using the blank fish, color or paint the fish and allow to dry. Cut out individual fish.

Game is played by standard Go-Fish rules:

Lay cards face down on table (or, if you are like my family, on the floor:)

Stir cards to mix thoroughly.

Deal five cards to each player. Place remaining cards in a pile, face down, in the center of the table/floor.

Youngest player goes first. Player 1 asks another child of his choice for a colored card corresponding to a color in his own hand, asking, "Do you have a (whatever color)." If the other player has the desired color, he hands it over to Player 1; if not, he says, "Go fish," and Player 1 draws a card. If a match is found, Player 1 places his color pair on the table and takes another turn. If no match is found, the play moves to the next child. Play continues until any player is out of cards.

Player with the most matches wins!

Tip: For more than three players, consider printing and coloring more pages of fish. You might make one set of solid colored fish, and one set of striped fish to give you more cards to play with.
