

Letter Match-Up Game

Instructions:

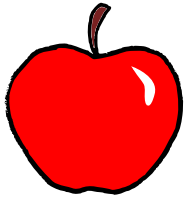
On heavy paper or cardstock, print out the three Letter Game pages. Cut on the heavy black lines to separate the pairs, and then choose to cut either on the gray dotted line for a puzzle-type game, or cut straight down the middle for a memory-style matching game.

Some ideas:

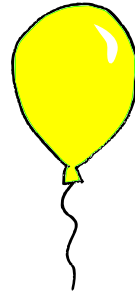
~ For a memory game, try printing on the blank side of some patterned scrapbooking paper. Laminate your entire sheet before cutting. This makes some extra cute and sturdy memory cards!

~For a puzzle game, try printing on t-shirt transfer paper, and iron onto white felt. Cut out the pieces and spread them out to stick on a flannel board.

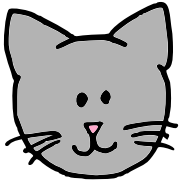
~OR print on cardstock, laminate, then cut out. Stick adhesive magnets on the backs of the pieces and stick them on your refrigerator!



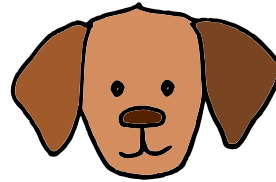
